David Livingstone, the first white man to claim to have discovered the falls, named it Victoria Falls after the Queen of England. The indigenous Mokololo people called it '*Mosi oa Tunya*', which translates to 'the smoke that thunders'.

TOUR OF THE FALLS

Victoria Falls, one of the Seven Wonders of the World, is renowned to have the most beautiful curtain of falling water in the world. A tour of the falls gives you a chance to watch 500 000

cubic meters per minute of water spill over the edge of the falls down into the gorge, crushing against the bottom rocks and sending an almighty spray soaring into the air.
