

Great Zimbabwe Ruins

It is remarkably strange and highly unusual to see such structures like Great Zimbabwe. The complex has endured for seven centuries. Great Zimbabwe ruins are the largest stone structure in Africa after the Pyramids. According to Historians, it is a sophisticated complex of buildings that



was going to house about 40 000 people at its height. The design of Great Zimbabwe is wholly African and the outer wall was purposely meant for defense by the then chief.

TOUR OF THE MONUMENTS

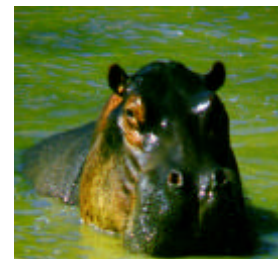
This guided tour of the monuments will take you around the ruins. The complex was built by a dry-stone technique with no

mortar binding the stone bricks. Explore the crevices and passages around the complex and experience the cool breeze that surrounds Great Zimbabwe. Tour of the hill complex will give you a picture of how the then chief used to defend himself.

GAME & SCENIC DRIVES



Scenic drives will take you to the Lakeshores of the man made Lake Mutirikwe, Zimbabwe's second largest dam. You will have a full view of the lake and the surroundings. On the game drives you have the chance to see a number of hippos,



buffaloes, warthogs and white rhinos.
